Clubs will be free for children in receipt of free school meals, adopted or Children Looked After by the local authority.

Club allocations will be completed once the form has closed and **you will receive an email informing you if your child has a place in their chosen clubs by Wednesday 18th September**. This will include all details for the club, including start and finish dates and times, cost for the term and any other relevant information. Unless otherwise stated, clubs will begin w/c 23rd September and run up to 13th December.

Many of our clubs are often very oversubscribed. Where this is the case, children will be placed onto a waiting list. Extra-curricular club options for term 2 (January-March) will be sent home nearer the time and priority will be given to children who may have been on waiting lists in term 1.
